<b>Uniform Curfew Hours</b>	May be imposed by LGUs, subject to the guidelines issued by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG). <i>Exception to curfew hours:</i> Workers, cargo vehicles, public transportation, and operating hours of permitted establishments shall not be restricted by such curfew.
