<b>FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS</b>		
<p><b>Foreign Nationals</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Negative RT-PCR test shall be required to be taken within seventy-two hours (72 hrs) prior to departure from the country of origin.</li> <li>Upon arrival, no facility-based quarantine will be further required.</li> <li>The passenger is enjoined to self-monitor for any symptoms until the 14th day with the first day being the date of arrival.</li> </ul> <p><b>Filipinos, OFWs and Non-OFWs (upon the option of the individual)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facility-based quarantine until the release of a negative RT-PCR test taken in the quarantine facility upon arrival; <b>OR</b></li> <li>When a negative RT-PCR test was taken within 72 hours prior to departure from the country of origin, no facility-based quarantine shall be required but the passenger is enjoined to self-monitor for any symptoms until the 14th day with the first day being the date of arrival.</li> </ul> <p>*Subject to the review on the infection rates for fully vaccinated arriving international travelers and its operational framework on the 14th date from effectivity of this Resolution.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test result taken on the 5th day; complete the 10-day home quarantine.</li> </ul> <p><i>Foreign nationals shall be required to secure pre-booked accommodation for at least 6 days.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All arriving travelers shall undergo 14-day quarantine upon arrival.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>10 days facility based; and</li> <li>4 days home quarantine.</li> </ul> </li> <li>RT-PCR testing on the 7th day, with day 1 being the day of arrival.</li> </ul> <p>Notwithstanding a negative RT-PCR test result, all travelers shall complete the 10-day facility based quarantine.</p>
<b>UNVACCINATED INDIVIDUALS, PARTIALLY VACCINATED, OR VACCINATION STATUS CANNOT BE INDEPENDENTLY VERIFIED</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facility-based quarantine until the release of a negative RT-PCR test taken on the 5th day and self-monitor until the 14th day of arrival with the date of arrival being the first day.</li> </ul> <p><i>Foreign nationals shall be required to secure hotel reservations for at least 6 days.</i></p> <p><b>Unvaccinated or partially unvaccinated minor children</b> traveling with their fully vaccinated parent/s or guardian/s shall be required to observe the quarantine protocols corresponding to their vaccination status. A parent/guardian shall accompany the child in the quarantine facility for the full term of the latter's facility-based quarantine period.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facility-based quarantine until the release of negative RT-PCR test result taken on the 7th day; complete the 14-day home quarantine.</li> </ul> <p><i>Foreign nationals shall be required to secure pre-booked accommodation for at least 8 days.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All arriving travelers shall undergo 14-day quarantine upon arrival.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>10 days facility based; and</li> <li>4 days home quarantine.</li> </ul> </li> <li>RT-PCR testing on the 7th day, with day 1 being the day of arrival.</li> </ul> <p>Notwithstanding a negative RT-PCR test result, all travelers shall complete the 10-day facility based quarantine.</p>
