REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONSIDERED AS FULLY VACCINATED	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Has received the second dose in a 2-dose, or a single dose COVID-19 vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation. 2. Possess and present any of the following proof of vaccination; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. WHO International Certificate of Vaccination and Prophylaxis; b. VaxCertPH; c. National or state manual/digital vaccination certificate of the country/foreign government; d. Other proof of vaccination.

TESTING REQUIREMENT	Present a remotely supervised, or a laboratory-based rapid antigen negative test result administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, pharmacy, or other similar establishment taken within twenty-four (24) hours, prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-	Undergo a laboratory-based rapid antigen negative test result administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, pharmacy, or other similar establishment taken upon arrival at the airport.	Shall follow the quarantine protocols of their parent/s or an accompanying adult/guardian traveling with them.	Present a remotely supervised, or a laboratory-based rapid antigen negative test result administered and certified by a healthcare professional in a healthcare facility, laboratory, clinic, pharmacy, or other similar establishment taken within twenty-four (24) hours, prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to the Philippines, excluding lay-overs; provided, that, he/she has not left the airport premises or has not been admitted into another country during such lay-over;
